Since Lake Hydra (formally Dutch Springs) is about 1 hour 45 minutes' drive and our days start very early and they are very long days, driving back and forth is not recommended. You need to make some overnight arrangements. The Sonesta Hotel is our preferred choice. But there are plenty of other options near the Lehigh Valley International Airport (about 15 min from Dutch Springs).

There are campsites in the area but fill up fast. There are several Airbnb options out there too.

- 1. You will need to come and get fitted for your rental gear, the sooner the better! We will set aside your rental package once you are fitted which *includes* 2 tanks, BCD, regulator, gauge, 2-piece 7mm wetsuit & hood until the week of training dives. You can come pick it up any time the Monday of Training Dive week. You are responsible for picking up your rentals before the class and returning it the week after the course (clean & dry please), we do not transport it out for you.
- 2. PLEASE remember to bring your weight belts to the store with you so we can fit you with the proper weights (you need 10% of body weight plus 4 pounds) so that we do not have to do it the morning of class at Dutch Springs. <u>Purchase of gloves are highly recommended.</u>
- 3. There is a BBQ lunch plus snacks both Saturday and Sunday. The fee is \$25 per person for the whole weekend. We collect onsite. If you do NOT want to participate or have dietary requirements, please call the store.
- 4. YOU MUST BUY YOUR TICKETS ONLINE and it must be done at least 2 days prior to the weekend. Follow directions below and will give you a discounted price on the entrance tickets which is \$60 per day per diver.
- *Advanced Open Water students should purchase entry tickets for both days and a Saturday night dive, as well as 4 air fill tickets. Rescue students should purchase entry tickets for both days plus one air fill ticket.
